So, what is a CSA?!

Community Supported Agriculture, a social and economic alternative to “conventional” industrial food production. ‘Shares’ of the harvest are purchased at the beginning of the growing season from the farm which then provides a weekly share of produce grown on the farm throughout the season.

Through CSAs, the community makes a bold statement in support of local, sustainable agriculture. This method spreads the economic risk of farming during the season among all invested members.

The benefits: the community gains a greater sense of responsibility and a closer connection to their food source, while the farmers receive up-front financial support for the growing season ahead. Everybody’s happy!

Here’s how it works:

C.S.A. shares are picked up weekly from July 2nd to October 8th 2013 for a total of 15 weeks.

Pickups are made at our farmstand on Tuesday of each week, from 11 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Each weekly C.S.A. Share will include a variety of seasonal produce (see below) and a beautiful flower bunch.
